New website: There are 3 off-site products available. Digital Sports, Max Preps and On-Line something (couldn't remember the name). Hockinson uses the last 2 sites.

The District has approved use of a site of the Administration's choice. Digital Sports costs \$500 for a year subscription. It will be live by Fall. We need to be sure & ask the parents to be patient while it's getting set up.
