Treasurer's Report: Gwen handed out Profit & Loss and Balance sheet. \$3800 total slot money for this year and last year.

President's Report: Scholarship forms are available. Martha Hancock has them at school and they're available in the bulletin too. Two (2) scholarships are available.

Principal's Report: Summer project for the fall is the new website. Will probably go with Digital Sports. Will have pictures, stats, etc. Will be given to Ed who will give to coaches to keep up. Considering using Student ASB funds for this. \$500 for 2 years.
